WEDNESDAY NIGHT SMALL GROUP FOR HIGH SCHOOLERS

Darleen Ortega will host a small group for high school students to discuss "Joan of Arcadia," a television series in which God appears to a teenage girl. God shows up in lots of different forms--the cute boy on the bus, the cafeteria worker at school, a UPS man delivering a package to her home, a child on the playground. Each time, God gives Joan something to do or poses a question for her to think about--and Joan, being a feisty teenage girl, argues and wheedles and doubts and opposes. But she also mostly obeys, and finds that God is usually up to something. This excellent series openly explores issues of faith in the context of the believable problems of a teenage girl and her parents and her two brothers. It proves to be great discussion fodder for our own faith struggles.
