Along with members of the wider Newberg community, we will meet in the Labyrinth immediately after the all-church dance. The event will commence with music and readings in both Spanish and English (we hope!). Then, beginning just before 9 pm, we will begin a *silent prayer walk* around the peace trail using phone flashlights and battery-powered votive candles to shine our collective lights as we raise our prayers.

There will be some chairs that remain on the labyrinth for those who prefer not to walk the path. At 9:30 we will gather again at the labyrinth to pray and close with music and community prayer.
