Sunday, October 6th is <u>FWCC's World Quaker Day</u>, which this year is focused on "Sustainability: Planting Seeds of Renewal for the World We Love." If you are unfamiliar with ReThreads, it is a free clothing ministry that is hosted by NVFC volunteers, and is open Fridays and Saturdays from 11am to 1pm, and the 1st Sunday of the month during fellowship time.
