We usually are more laissaez faire as fare as "drop by if you can" but will need to have folks register so we make sure we can adequately physically distance. It will be great to see some of you and work "near" each other!

A note from our clerk, Silas Olson

Since the shutdown began, Administrative Committee has met twice via Zoom and plans to continue meeting monthly for the time being. As per our bylaws, AC is convening and making decisions in lieu of a gathered meeting for worship for business until we can regather in person again. Last week, AC made the following three decisions:

- 1. Since the pastoral calls for Leslie Murray and Nate Macy come to an end on June 30, 2020 the AC extended both of their calls for one year. The Elders have expressed a desire to engage in a more meaningful call renewal process with each pastor than they were able to conduct this year, so it is our hope that those meaningful processes can occur next year.
- 2. AC approved a 6-month budget continuation. On July 1, 2020 the budgets will be set to the same levels as they were on July 1, 2019. We recognize the importance of the ministries happening now, even if they look a little different than we expected. Staff have been asked to use discretion in using funds during this time and Finance Committee will continue to monitor and evaluate NVFC cash flow, particularly until we are able to be together again.

3. North Valley is aware of a deadline imposed by NW Yearly Meeting pertaining to whether or not NVFC affiliates with Sierra Cascades Yearly Meeting of Friends. While not dictating the timing of our discernment process overall, NW Yearly Meeting set aside a portion of its ministry fund in 2018 and stated they would transfer those funds to SCYMF if NVFC decided to affiliate with SCYMF on or before June 30, 2021. Considering our current inability to discern together in person, AC authorized Noel Carey (Clerk of Elders) and Silas Olson (NVFC Clerk) to send a letter to NW Yearly Meeting requesting an extension of the NW Yearly deadline to June 30, 2022 in order for NVFC to complete our discernment process together.
