A quick note for parents:

At the beginning of each youth gathering, we are going to be performing health screenings of each teenager. We will be taking temperatures, and asking the following questions. (You can help us out by performing a "pre-screening" with your teens before they arrive by asking them these questions)

- Do you have any symptoms of COVID-19? (cough, fever, shortness of breath, sore throat, loss of taste or smell)
- Have you had close contact with someone with a presumptive or confirmed case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- If your teen has a high temperature, or answers "yes" to either question, they will be asked to return home.

Please stick around for a minute after you drop off your teen for youth group, and wait for the Thumbs Up. Please also be timely in picking up teens after youth group. We'll be diligent at ending on time, and in order for us to get ready for the next group, we'll need to put our focus on sanitizing.

Thanks for your work in helping in keeping us all safe.
