DR. DAVID NIYONZIMA @ NVFC | SUNDAY, OCTOBER 27

Next Sunday, October 27th, we have invited Dr. David Niyonzima to share with us during programmed worship. Dr. Niyonzima is a pastor and professional psychotherapist who founded *Trauma Healing and Reconciliation Services (THARS)* in 2000 to promote psychological approaches to rebuilding communities after the atrocities in his home country of Burundi. He will speak about his experience of the genocide, and how God called him to promote reconciliation rather than taking revenge into his own hands. We are excited to host Dr. Niyonzima as he speaking in various churches this month to fundraise for his work in Burundi and share his message of trauma healing, reconciliation, and peace.
