"OUT OF MY MIND" - Thoughts from Colin Saxton

I am still ruminating on the Luke 3 passage where John the Baptist gives us some practical (and passionate!) examples of caring for others: Share your extra. Make a place at the table for those who have no food to eat. Never take advantage of others—ever. Such actions may not change the entire world, but might change it for someone—including ourselves.

The early church took these admonitions and Jesus' even more radical teachings seriously. If we continue reading through the two-part volume of Luke/Acts, we find in Acts 2 how the disciples brought their gifts and resources to the Apostles, who distributed them among those in need. Along with caring for members of the faith community, there is plenty of evidence that the church cared for the poor, orphaned, widowed, and marginalized far beyond the worshiping fellowship.

When alone, we can easily feel overwhelmed and perplexed about how to live faithfully in the Way of Jesus. However, in community, there's often a greater capacity for faith, burden-sharing, and wisdom to discern the best way to give. I know this isn't always true. Communities can just as easily become insular, miserly, and self-focused if they are not careful.

Recent changes to our staffing model may free up resources, allowing us to be more generous with others. Instead of focusing on "how we are saving money," I would love for us to engage in some more prayerful discernment around how we can share more generously with others—both within and outside our fellowship. Who knows how it might change things!
